

## ORDINANCE NO. 2021-09

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF QUINTANA, TEXAS, FIXING AND LEVYING MUNICIPAL AD VALOREM TAXES FOR SAID TOWN FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2021, AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2022, DIRECTING THE ASSESSMENT AND COLLECTION THEREOF; PROVIDING A SEVERANCE CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT AND BE IN FORCE FROM AND AFTER ITS PASSAGE. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF QUINTANA, TEXAS:


**This year's levy to fund maintenance and operations expenditures does not exceed last year's maintenance and operations tax levy.**

**Section 1.** That for the current expenses of the Town of Quintana, Texas, and for the general improvement of the Town and its property there, it is hereby levied and ordered assessed and collected during the fiscal year, which will begin October 1, 2021 and will end September 30, 2022, on all property, real, personal, and mixed, lying situated within the Corporate Limits of the Town of Quintana, Texas, and not exempt from taxation by valid laws, an ad valorem tax rate at the rate of \$.015423 per One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars valuation of such property for operation and maintenance purposes.

**Section 2.** That the City Secretary is authorized to notify the Brazoria County Tax Assessor-Collector to assess and enter upon the tax rolls of the Town of Quintana, Texas, the amount and rate herein levied and to keep a correct account of same, collect the same, and when so collected, to distribute same, in accordance with this Ordinance.

**Section 3.** That in the event any section or provision of this Ordinance is found unconstitutional, void, or inoperative, such defective section or provision, if any, is hereby declared to be severable from the remaining sections and provisions of this Ordinance and such remaining sections and provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

**Section 4.** That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. **READ, PASSED, AND ADOPTED**, this 24th day of August, 2021, A.D., in Quintana, Texas, at Town Hall at 6:02pm.
